DSPO Releases New 2024 Suicide Prevention Awareness Month Toolkit and New Resources

Suicide Prevention Awareness Month Message to the Force

The Honorable Ashish S. Vazirani, performing the Duties of the Under Secretary of Defense for Personnel and Readiness, released a Message to the Force in honor of Suicide Prevention Awareness Month. The message encourages the Total Force to reach out for help when it is needed. He stated that mental health is just as important as physical health.

Mr. Vazirani also explains that Joining the Fight: Connect to Protect is the new Suicide Prevention Awareness Month campaign and it will be promoted throughout the year. Events and programs will be planned around Secretary of Defense Lloyd J. Austin's Five Lines of Effort which include, Fostering a Supportive Environment, Improving the Delivery of Mental Health Care, Addressing Stigma and Other Barriers to Care, Revising Suicide Prevention Training, and Promoting a Culture of Lethal Means Safety.

Mr. Vazirani acknowledged that suicide is a public health issue, and the community must address prevention through multiple strategies. The Department and its partners must Join the Fight to end suicide.
